Vaccines Needed for 7th Grade Students

ALSO Students in 8th, 9th and 10th who have not had these vaccines are required to get them before the first day of the

2017-2018 School Year

- MCV4 (Meningococcal {meningitis}) vaccine
- Tdap vaccine (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis {whooping cough})

We will also have Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine available, this vaccine is optional

These vaccines are needed in addition to current school vaccination requirements.

**** Please check with your child's doctor to see if they have already received them, and take a copy of the record to their school.****
