





Students learning at their own pace through videos, projects, etc.




Online classes learning together through video conferencing






Students can learn and review at their own pace





Flexibility for students learning in different time zones








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Teachers can include a range of student paced learning tools and give feedback accordingly



Respectful	 Stay muted until it is your turn to talk. Take turns speaking (use chat or raise hand option). Give others time to talk. Find a space where you will not be disturbed or disturb others. 	 Keep volume low (and/or use headphones). Schedule time to share devices with others if necessary. Find a space where you will not be disturbed or disturb others. 	Select a space that allows for minimal distraction to others.	
Responsible	 Keep eyes and ears on the teacher/task/activity. Stay on learning page. Keep all other pages closed. Participate. Protect your password. Contact your teacher if you are having a problem logging in. Be a good friend - help others to sign in if you notice they are having trouble 	 Take breaks. Keep eyes and ears on the task/activity. Protect your password. Access only approved/parent allowed websites. 	 Complete tasks. Ask for help when needed. Follow your schedule and work on each class. 	
Resilient	 Log in 5 minutes early. If the code is not working, try to log in again a few minutes later. 	 Plan for screen time. If you are having trouble focusing, take a mental break and try again, or choose a different activity. 	 If you run into technology issues, get help from an adult.
