### Dear Patapsco Families:

It was so wonderful to see our students and families at our orientation and open house yesterday. The orientation PowerPoint is available <a href="here">here</a>.

I wanted to send this issue of Knightly News to highlight the first day of school. All of the information that is included in our Knightly News will also be posted on our website.

School starts at 8:05AM and ends at 2:50PM. The doors to the building open at 8:00AM. Breakfast will be available at no-cost to all students starting at 7:50 AM. As in years prior, students will wait outdoors prior to the opening bell unless we experience heavy precipitation or extreme temperatures. There are multiple entrances to the building and students will enter the building by their assigned lockers. Students who take the bus will need to make sure they are at their bus stop early in case the bus arrives early but be prepared it could also be a few minutes late. For families who are arriving by car:

- Follow the traffic arrows at the end of the driveway to make a circular loop into the drop off area
- Only buses, staff, and county vehicles will be permitted to enter the parking lot during drop-off and pick-up times.

• Seek assistance from the staff member stationed by the drop off area. They will be happy to help you in any way possible.

#### WHAT SUPPLIES DO I NEED FIRST DAY?

All students please come with your HCPSS assigned Chromebook (charged),a couple of pencils, a notebook, and a binder. You can bring in more supplies as the week progresses. Students will be able to use their locker and backpack. We will help all students with their lockers throughout the entire week. We know lockers are a big deal and also can be scary for students- we will be here ready to show patience and care.

All students must bring and wear a **mask** in the building and on their bus. We also encourage students to bring a water bottle.

#### **REMINDERS**

- Lunch and breakfast are available for all students at no-cost
- students, staff, and visitors must wear a mask
- be patient with bus times for the first few days
- Lockers and backpacks may be used
- Do not send your student to school sick

### Does my student need their HCPSS issued Chromebook everyday?

• Yes. Please bring your fully charged Chromebook everyday. Any student that does not have a Chromebook from the previous school year will be assigned one on Monday.

#### What time does the bus arrive?

#### Where does my student report to on Monday morning?

Students will report to homeroom everyday.

Yes. Weather and staffing permitted. We will have seating for students to utilize if they
want to eat outside.

### What is the cell phone policy?

 All cell phones must be put away upon entering the building. Students may carry their phone and it must be silent but it may not be used during the day. Expectations will be shared with students the first week of school.

### **Update Your Family File!**

Family File is now available for the 2021-22 school year: Parents can now access and complete the FAMILY FILE for this year and it is done through HCPSS CONNECT. Parents must complete the Family File every year to ensure HCPSS has the most current information for each child. Once logged in, parents/guardians will be asked to verify, or update the following information: Student Information, Parent/Guardian Contact, Emergency Contact, Medical Information, Arrival/Dismissal Procedures, Photo Approval, Data Confidentiality, PTA/PTSA Directory.

Updating your information, including EMAIL addresses and contact information, and **pushing the SUBMIT button** will ensure that you are receiving the most recent news from Patapsco Middle School.

# **Quarantining Procedures**

The <u>close contact and quarantining procedures</u> that were put into place last year will remain this fall. Only unvaccinated students and adults who are identified as close contacts must quarantine. *Vaccinated students and staff will not be required to quarantine* unless they receive a positive test or are displaying symptoms, but are expected to monitor their symptoms

closely for the 14 days. <u>Instructional supports</u> are in place for students who must quarantine. Students will be able to see when their teachers are available through their canvas page.

## **Medication Drop Off**

If your student takes medicine during the school day, please drop it off on Monday, August 30 between 8:00 and 2:30 PM.

# **COVID-19 Self-Screening Symptoms Self Check**

Parents/guardians should **keep their children home if they are experiencing symptom(s)** associated with any communicable disease, including COVID-19. In addition, parents/guardians are to perform the following COVID-19 health check every day before the student leaves home.

A child should **NOT** come to school with any of these symptoms:

- Fever of 100.4 degrees or higher
- Sore throat
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Diarrhea or vomiting
- New onset of severe headache (especially with fever), or New loss of taste or smell

For persons with chronic conditions such as asthma, the symptoms should represent a change from baseline.
