Media Center Reminders:

As a reminder students should be bringing a charged chromebook and charger with them each and every day. This helps students be prepared with their tools for the day.

There are a limited number of loaner chromebooks available. Only students with repairs will be allowed to check out a loaner for the day.

What happens when a student forgets their device at home and doesn't have a repair?

- Call home if a parent / guardian is available to bring in
- Given a paper copy of an assignment / work with a partner
- Desktop available in media center to complete online assignments

We have also seen an increase in students not having charged devices. Chargers are also limited and will not be available to check out for the day.

Teachers have a limited number of chargers available in their classrooms if a student needs to charge during class. Students are given reminders to charge their devices at home and to bring their chargers with them to school.

What happens if a student loses their charger?

- Check with each of their classroom teachers
- Check at home and in vehicles
- Request a replacement

Replacement chargers are \$25 and can be requested by going to the media center and speaking with Mrs. Snyder or Mrs. Murach. Once posted to a student's account payments will be seen in your students My School Bucks account. You can check their account at http://myschoolbucks.com/.

Heart and Sole helps girls (this includes any female-identifying and non-binary young people) unleash their potential by focusing on five key things: body, brain, heart, spirit, and connection. Heart and Sole is the 6th-8th grade Girls on the Run program. Coaches inspire girls to value what makes them unique, and together, participants uncover confidence and understand the importance of physical and emotional health. Girls work on setting goals geared toward physical and emotional health, and actualize those goals through exercise, discussion, and connection.

The spring program runs from Monday, March 20th (first practice) to Monday, June 5th (end-of-year celebration). Each season ends with a noncompetitive 5K (Saturday, June 3) where girls celebrate who they are, how far they have come, and where they want to go. The program will run after school on Mondays and Thursdays from 2:50 pm - 4:15 pm.
