## Update Your 2024-2025 Family File - Please submit before August 26!

Family File is now available in <u>HCPSS Connect</u> for the 2024-25 school year. Parents must complete the Family File every year to ensure HCPSS has the most current information for each child. Updating your information—including email addresses and contact information—and clicking the submit button will ensure that you are receiving the most recent news from Patapsco Middle School.

## **Change of Address**

Changes of address may not be made through Family File. If you have recently moved, please contact your child's new school as soon as possible. As we are preparing for the upcoming 2024-2025 school year, it is imperative that we have accurate addresses on file for all of our students. If you have moved, and have not provided us with your updated information, we ask that you email the following documents to PMSRegistrars@hcpss.org:

- Completed change of address form <u>Click here to download PDF fillable version</u>
- A deed or deed of trust that has all required signatures or an original lease with all required signatures
- A current bill for cable television, non-cellular telephone, or gas and electric.

#### **Chromebooks**

Any student who was issued a Chromebook in a previous year will continue to use that device during the 2024-2025 school year. Sixth grade students and students new to HCPSS will have access to a Chromebook; parents/guardians do not need to do anything to request this device. Details for student device distribution will be communicated as soon as they are available.

#### Lockers

Every student will be issued a locker during the first week of school. Students will be able to access their lockers before school, before and after lunch, and after school. Students are

permitted to carry their backpack during the school day.

#### From The Health Room

#### **Immunizations**

Maryland State Department of Health and Mental Hygiene requires all incoming 7th grade students in the state of Maryland to have one Tdap and one Meningitis vaccine BEFORE entering school.

Some students may have already received these immunizations, but the Health Room may not have the updated immunization record. Please contact your child's health care provider and send or fax an updated copy of your child's immunizations to the Health Room. The fax number at Patapsco Middle Health Room is 410-313-1741. Immunizations may also be sent to Theresa Anderson, school nurse, at theresa\_anderson@hcpss.org

Failure to provide proof of updated immunizations by the first day of school, or to provide evidence of an appointment to receive those immunizations within 20 calendar days from the first day of school, will result in your student being excluded from school. If you have any questions, please contact the school nurse.

## 2024-2025 Free and Reduced Meals (FARMs)

Many HCPSS families are eligible to participate in the Free and Reduced Price Meals (FARMs) program, which provides children with a wide range of benefits including free or discounted college tuition, testing and application fees, academic and athletic program fees and many others in addition to free or discounted meals. Families are urged to check their eligibility and complete a FARMs application as soon as possible. Families must submit a new application every school year.
