### **MCAP Reports**

On 9/22, students will be bringing home results from the Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP). Results are for the spring 2022 mathematics and English Language

Arts/Literacy (ELA/L) assessments in Grades 3 through 8, Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, and English 10. This was the first full administration of the MCAP assessments that have replaced the previous Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) program. The assessments use a four-point score scale, with students performing at levels 3 and 4 considered proficient for their grade level or course content.

### Heart & Sole

Heart and Sole (Girls on the Run program for 6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> graders) helps girls (this includes any female-identifying and non-binary young people) unleash their potential by focusing on five key things: body, brain, heart, spirit, and connection. Participants work on setting goals geared toward physical, emotional, and relational health, and actualize those goals through exercise, community building, and connection.

The fall season runs from Monday, September 18th (first practice) to Monday, December 4th (end-of-year celebration). Each season ends with a noncompetitive 5K (Saturday, December 2nd) where participants celebrate who they are, how far they have come, and where they want to go. The program will run after school on Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:30 pm - 4:45 pm and will meet in Ms. Kelly's room (A4).
