From the Principal's Desk...

Parent/Teacher Conferences are scheduled for November 21-23, 2022 and will be held in-person on Monday, November 21st and virtually on Tuesday and Wednesday, November 22nd-23rd. From Monday, November 7th at 8:00am, through Thursday, November 17th at 4:00pm, parents/guardians can log into HCPSS Connect to view and select available time slots to meet with teachers.

The purpose of this conference window is to allow parents/guardians the opportunity for a virtual meet and greet with staff to discuss general student progress. Accordingly, each conference slot is 15 minutes long and will be conducted **in-person on Monday and through google meets on Tuesday and Wednesday**. If you have a pressing concern, you are strongly encouraged to contact the teacher to discuss it outside of the conference window. Synergy Conference

Management allows users to schedule time with individual teachers. We do not recommend scheduling your conferences back-to-back (on Monday) as you will lose meeting time while walking to each conference.

To permit access to our staff by all parents with interest, we ask that parents schedule conferences only for those classes for which there are concerns. Unlike your experience in elementary school, middle level educators do not have a slot for each and every student. So, please be strategic about who you'd like to see and mindful of the need for your neighbors to have the same access.

Home report PDFs for the Measure of Academic Progress (MAP) fall testing are now available in HCPSS Connect. The assessment was given to students in grades 1-8 in reading and mathematics. Reports can be viewed/downloaded by Parents/guardians by taking the following steps:

- 1. Log in to HCPSS Connect Synergy
- 2. Select More Options from the left panel
- 3. Select Report Cards from the menu
- 4. Near the top of the page, select MAP_2022_FALL Note: Students in Algebra I/II or Geometry, and English 8 G/T do not participate in MAP testing. If your child did not participate in the October administration, a report may still appear based on the previous administration.
